

PRIVACY POLICY

Brampton Adult Soccer ("BAS") takes privacy seriously. BAS may collect personally identifiable information in the course of operating our league and this Web site (the "Site"). BAS has created this privacy policy to address questions regarding personally identifiable information that is collected at the Site and how it is used or disseminated.

By using our Site you consent to the collection and use of your information by BAS as set forth in this Policy.

Personal Information Privacy Principles

We collect, use, and otherwise process any personal information Site users provide us or that we otherwise gather on this Site in accordance with the following principles:

Accountability:

- BAS will only collect personal information that is required or legitimate in the course of normal operations.
- BAS will advise third parties that process information on BAS's behalf to provide a comparable level of privacy protection in respect of such information.

Identifying Purposes, Obtaining Consent and Limiting Use:

- When collecting personal information, BAS will disclose the purpose for the information collection and will obtain consent, when required, to allow BAS to use the information in the course of normal operations.
- Please note that if the collection, use or disclosure of personal information is required or permitted by law, BAS will not seek specific consent.

Safeguards:

- BAS safeguards personal information by employing security measures that are appropriate to the sensitivity level of the information in question.
- However, as effective as our security measures are, no security system is impenetrable. We cannot guarantee the security of our database, nor can we guarantee that information you supply will not be intercepted while being transmitted to us over the Internet. We ask that you do your part to ensure security of personal information, by maintaining any computer passwords you use to access the Site strictly confidential.

Openness, Accuracy, Access and Challenging Compliance:

- BAS may make available specific information about BAS's policies and practices as they relate to the management of personal information.
- Upon being advised in writing of any inaccuracies, BAS will make the required changes to any personal information in our possession.
- BAS will investigate every complaint related to BAS's compliance with this Policy. If BAS finds a complaint to be justified, appropriate measures will be taken, including, if necessary, amending its policies and practices.

Information We May Collect; Information Use

BAS may collect personally identifiable information, including name, gender, address, e-mail address, and phone numbers when you correspond with us or submits questions or comments to us through the Site. We do not require you to provide personal information to obtain access to the public portions of our Site.

Any personal information we maintain about us will be used for the purpose indicated on the Site or as stated in this policy. BAS collects information to facilitate the services offered on this Site and to provide better and more useful services to the users of the Site, and to respond to queries or requests of users. If you submit personal information to us through this Site, we may use your information to send periodic mailings or e-mails to you with information about services and products that are offered by BAS or upcoming events that we think may be of interest to you. If you supply us with your telephone number, we may call you in order to respond to your request, and we may, from time to time call you with

information regarding new products and services or upcoming events that we believe may be of interest to you.

If you do not want us to send you mail or e-mail or to call you to provide you with information regarding new products, services or promotions please see the section entitled "**Access, Amendment, and Deletion**" below.

The information collected on this Site is stored on servers located in Canada.

Cookies and Other Non-Identifiable Information

Like many Web sites, this Site may use 'cookies' from time to time to provide useful information to you. Cookies are pieces of information that a Web site transfers to your computer's hard disk for record keeping purposes. Cookies can make the web more useful for you by storing information about your preference on a particular site. Cookies do not personally identify users although they do identify a user's computer. Most Internet browsers are set to accept cookies. If you'd like, you can turn this feature off so that your computer will not accept cookies. Personal Information Sharing Practices

When you share personal information on this Site, you are sharing that information with BAS. We will not sell, exchange or otherwise distribute your personally identifiable information without your consent, except to the extent required by law, in accordance with your instructions, in accordance with our governing bodies, or as otherwise set out in this Policy.

BAS may share your personal information with third party business partners or service providers so that they may provide services to BAS that are consistent with the terms of this privacy policy. As we continue to develop our league, we take on additional responsibilities. In such occurrences, user information generally is one of the transferred assets. Therefore, if either any BAS company itself or substantially all of its assets were acquired, your personal information may be one of the transferred assets. BAS may also disclose personal information collected through this Site in special circumstances when we have reason to believe that disclosing such information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who has violated the law, this Web site's Terms of Use or BAS's rights, or someone who is interfering with or causing injury to BAS's property. BAS may also disclose personal information when BAS believes in good faith that such disclosure is required by law or necessary to protect other Site users or the public.
